Presentation

The Master is delivered by the University of Milan in partnership with IRCCS "Carlo Besta" Neurological Institute.

It will provide the attendees with a complete update on Peripheral Nervous System (PNS) Disorders.

The way is structured will allow widening knowledge of PNS physiology and disease-related dysfunctions, and acquiring theoretical and practical skills on structure, development and function of peripheral neurons and nerves, clinical neurophysiology and autonomic nervous system, neuroimaging, neuropathology, diagnosis and treatment of acquired and inherited neuropathies, pain, motor neuron diseases and neuromuscular junction diseases.

The Master will provide 60 credits.

VENUE

The Master will be held in the main building of the University of Milan (INFOGIURE hall), via Festa del Perdono, 7 – Milan, Italy

TUITION FEES

The tuition fee is 5,000 euros and includes: educational material, access to a personal website room, slides and recorded lessons, insurance, guided city tours, social dinners, round-trip train ticket to the University of Turin for the cadaver lab, one social event for each module

The tuition fee does not include meals, travel and accommodation costs.

PNS SUPPORT

The Peripheral Nerve Society will grant 10 participants from low-income countries admitted to the course with a scholarship of 2,500 euros to cover part of the tuition fee. The remaining part of the fee (2,500 euros) will have to be covered by the participant.

HOW TO APPLY

The Master is intended for graduates in **Medicine, Biology**, or related **biomedical and healthcare fields** who wish to deepen their knowledge and develop expertise and research skills in Peripheral Nervous System disorders.

PhD students and neurology residents are particularly encouraged to apply. The program is designed for those interested in pursuing a career in translational neuroscience, either in academia or in the industry.

Pre-application must be submitted online and must include an updated CV (including direct contacts – email and mobile number) as well as a personal statement for the participation in the Master.

The deadline for the submission is April, 9, 2026.

All candidates will undergo an interview through Zoom (or similar platform) with the Faculty Board.

Interviews will be scheduled starting from April 21, 2026

Candidates selected for the interviews will be informed accordingly no later than April 30, 2026.

The Master will accept from a minimum of 15 to a maximum of 25 students.

Students must attend the entire course ONSITE and pass the final exam, planned for November 2027, to attain the Master's degree.

Only students from low and middle-income countries – World Bank Country Classifications – will be allowed of an e-learning attendance.
